SOMERSET COUNTY MARYLAND 1850 Ruth Dryden

CROCKETT FAMILY - FROM CORNWALL, ENGLAND - WICOMICO CO.

The first mention of the Crockett family on the Eastern Shore was in the will of Nickolas Rice 1677/78 to Richard Crockett. This Richard with sons Robert and John were in Wicomico Hundred in 1724, name spelled Crocet.

DIES Dise, Dyes FAMILY FROM SPAIN BY WAY OF ACCOMACK

The name Dise was spelled various ways on the early records Robert Dies was in Annemessex Hundred in 1724. He came to the County in 1665 from Accomack Co. Va. with Charles Ballard.

EVANS FAMILY FROM SOUTH EASTERN WALES - ACCOMACK

The Evans family was in Accomack Co. Va. as early as 1651. John Evans Sr. listed his age there as 68 in 1698. Early settlers in Somerset Co. were Nicholas, and John and Edward. John d 1686 in Wicomico Hundred. The 1724 tax list includes Elizabeth, John Sr. with Nicholas and John Jr. in Wicomico Hundred. In Pocomoke were Thomas with Nathaniel and in Baltimore Hundred were the widow Mary with John and a William. There were probably more than one Evans family there by that time by the name of EVANS.

Note: Most if not all of the Evans on Smith Island descended from John Evans w 1721 from Accomack.

MARSHALL FAMILY FROM ENGLAND - ST MARYS - Somerset - ACCOMACK

Geogre Marshall who d. 1675 St Mary's County left a son Adrain. Adrain evidently came to Somerset Co. and married Elizabeth Long. Her will dated 1716/17 named sons George Sameul, Thomas, adrain and Adria. George Marshall was at Pocomoke Hundred in 1724.

MESSICK Damos Quaker - Pigeon House - HOLLAND Somerset County

Mezick also spelled Messick, Messex, Mezicks was first noted in Somerset Co. when he married Sarah Covington 10 Jun 1661. He evedently married 2nd Priscilla NicholSEN as his will dated 1715 named wife Priscilla and her sons Joseph, Isaac Benjamin, Julian Sarah and Mary. His older children wer Joshua John Nehemiah and Jacob. The later three were listed in Nanticoke Hundred in 1724.

SMITH FAMILY FROM ENGLAND - ACCOMACK & Somerset WICOMICO WORCESTER

As everywhere, there are a number of Smith families in Somerset Co. even as early as 1700. The most notable was Capt. Henry Smith from Accomack Co Va. in 1669. He patented large tracts of land in the Manokin section. He died in 1703 leaving sons Henry, William, John and Tomasen however in 1715 a John Smith of Sussex Co. as sole surviving male heir and grandson of Henry sold the land in Somerset Co. The 1724 tax lists show William, Robert and Edward Smith in Manokin; Henry Smith in Annemessex; Thomas Smith in Nanticoke; James with Mark in Wicomoco and others in now Worcester Co.

WHEN MY MOTHER (MARY C. PARKS EVANS) MOTHER DIED, SHE CAME UP TO STAY WITH AUNT MARTHA TO HELP HER. SHE WAS ABOUT 11 OR 12. ALL THE CHILDREN FELT AS THOUGH SHE WAS THEIR SISTER.
