Ewell is sometimes referred to as the "capital of Smith Island." It is the most visited by ferry access and services. Most packing houses are located in the center of the island from 1850's center-gabled houses to modern modular homes and trailers. Many homes were built from nearby Holland Island where erosion is a problem.

A WALKING TOUR OF EWELL

1. Tyler House. The former residence of the Tyler family is now operated by the National Park Service as a natural interpretive center and headquarters for the Glenn L. Martin Wildlife Refuge.
2. Sunken Remains of the Island Belle. The first island ferry boat.
3. Goat Island. Domestic goats were released here _____ years ago and have multiplied into a herd that number approximately _____ today.
4. Pitchcroft. Smith Island's first settlement, originally called Pittcraft, was the location of the island's oldest home until 19____ when it burned. _____ British soldiers from the Revolutionary War are allegedly buried here. Their graves are marked by tombstones on the left hand side of the trail. Until 19____ a British flag, donated by the United Kingdom was flown over this spot.
5. Ruke's Store (Miss Willie's or Old Store). Small rustic country store with recently added dining area. Is a local gathering place and social center. Has a gift department that resembles a local flea market.
6. Ewell United Methodist Church, Cemetery and Parsonage. The parsonage was rebuilt in 1937 after being destroyed by fire. Because of the high water table, many graves are above ground. Deceased are taken by boat to a Crisfield mortuary for embalming and returned for funeral services.
